Pastor's <u>Report</u>

Glædelig jul!

It's time to start thinking about Christmas cards and Christmas presents, we enjoy all the Christmas lights and wish each other 'Merry Christmas' in December. But in Danish everything is about JUL. Julenisser, jule-træer, jule-knas og jule-stads. Clearly the word Christmas has something to do with Christ, so why is it all about 'jul' in Danish?

We already know the word 'jul' from the old Norse Viking word: 'yuletide'. Yuletide existed before the Vikings ever had heard about Christ; they celebrated Winter Solstice on December 21st and this is one of the oldest winter celebrations in the world. The season was known as 'yule' or 'jul' and the word simply means party or feast and maybe it has something to do with the Danish word: hjul (wheel).

In late December the year is turning, just like a wheel, and starts over. So, when Christianity was introduced to the Vikings, they simply kept the word 'jul' and celebrated a new beginning, the birth of Jesus.

This year I believe we are all hoping for a new beginning! I think we all wish for a Merry Christmas and a festive Yuletide season. So, at the Danish Church we have tried to make Christmas plans as usual, the wheels are turning and we are ready to invite you and your family for Christmas Workshop, Christmas Concert, Lucia, Juleaften and so much more.

Follow us on Facebook and Instagram to keep up with dates, time and restrictions! Everything might change as we go along, and we will do our best to keep you posted by emails and on our website too.

Nothing was normal when they celebrated the very first Christmas way back when in Bethlehem, but they still managed to make it. The first Christmas became a night to remember and even the old Vikings far away heard of this Holy Night and changed their traditions to celebrate a new beginning in Christ. Because that little old stable in Bethlehem had something in it that was bigger than our whole world.

Let's follow our ancestors' example and celebrate new beginnings this season! This is a very busy season for Pastor Susanne, as you will note from all the services being held in December.


