Annual Report for 2021

2021 was not the year we were to get rid of Covid-19. It is still with us at the end of the year.

The Church was closed for the first part of the year. That was when Pastor Susanne and Søren saved us by sending out the weekly video with the sermon. Thank you again for that great job.

By May we were allowed to gather outside for services. We were lucky with the weather, it stayed dry during the services. A group of people met early Sunday morning to set up chairs, sound system and the altar on the driveway by the front door. In June the restrictions eased up a little and we were allowed inside the church. We moved the pews out to the wall and marked the seats with 6 feet spacing. We were all happy to be back inside again and to be able to have communion.

By the end of the summer the vaccines were here and the vaccine passports. We made it mandatory to be vaccinated and show passport to enter the building, that open up for church coffee and church lunch.

July 11th we were finally able to have our annual AGM, which went very well. We had 45 members in attendance.

In August we had a takeout sandwich day, very successful. I think people had gone a



long time without being able to get together with friends for lunch.

In September we had a visit from Bishop Marianne Gaarden from DSUK. She had meetings with Granly and Burnaby Churches. It was a good opportunity for us to show the Bishop what we are all about as it was her first visit to Canada. Secretary General Selma Ravn was also supposed to come along for the visit, but unfortunately, she got sick the day before they were to leave and had to stay home.

The fall bazaar went ahead with some restrictions. We had all the booths set up, but we had to limit the number of people in the hall, so it was by appointment only. We had also made more space for sitting down with proper distance to eat.

Christmas went ahead with a lot of restrictions. The Christmas concert and the Lucia performance was great, but we had to eliminate the coffee downstairs after the performance, as it was just too many people in the same place at the same time. But it was nice to have Christmas at the Church again.

As you might know, Granly is closing at the end of the year, and the property has been sold.

They have received \$1,000,000.00 in down payment, and they have given \$100,000.00 to each of the four Canadian Danish Churches.

Thank you so much Granly.

It is Granly's wish to establish a scholarship fund in their name, and they have asked the Burnaby Church to administrate the scholarship which we have agreed to do. That is the reason we will be dealing with some Constitution and Bylaw changes at the AGM. We want to make sure our By-laws are up to date, so we will be able to achieve what we need to.

We are also proposing to lower the quorum from 40 members to 30 members for the AGM.

Did you know?

More about our Memorial Walk Volunteer and Board Member, Poul Erik Rasmussen, after his work with Dr. Albert Schweitzer.

In July 1962 Poul Erik helped friends in France set up a “Center Albert Schweitzer” which was to aide people needing to start a new life after addictions, etc. While in France he bought a hilltop farmhouse with some land, and spends part of his vacation there each year.

He also met and married his future wife, Catherine, in Alsace, France in 1967. Poul Erik and his wife then settled down in Switzerland to good jobs. Prior his marriage Poul Erik had worked in Greenland to make up some earnings for his years of volunteering. The couple both wanted to travel and decided to go to Canada for two years, but stayed permanently and adopting baby Karen. The family loved spending time in the outdoors, camping in Beautiful British Columbia. In Vancouver Poul Erik upgraded his schooling to include a BCIT Forestry Technician’s Certificate. He worked as a job site foreman for general contractors in the Lower Mainland during his working life.

Other things that may surprise you – Poul Erik took a commercial diving course in Los Angeles, and worked at Expo 86 demonstrating hard-hat diving equipment. He took a diving course at SFU and became qualified to teach scuba diving and had his own classes.

Catherine was also a diver and they were often diving in the coastal waters of BC and Washington.

In addition to his French holiday retreat, Poul Erik has what he describes as a small summerhouse in Denmark and visits regularly. Sadly, in 1989, when their daughter Karen was 13 years old, Catherine lost her year-long battle with cancer and passed away.
