We are grateful that DSUK and the church board are giving us this opportunity and we are very much looking forward to spending a period of time together with you all at the Danish church. With those of you who still remember us from so many years ago there will be some catching up to do, and we are also looking forward to getting to know those of you who were not part of the church in the eighties and nineties.
