Pastor's Report

Dear congregation,

Is it just me or does spring always seem to be a lot shorter than autumn? During spring I believe we have so many things to celebrate that time simply flies. Whereas autumn lack such celebrations – at least in Denmark where we do not celebrate Thanksgiving and where Halloween only slowly is getting to be a tradition that we are getting accustomed to.

Starting with Fastelavn, spring shows itself as a season full of celebrations. Then Easter comes with all its various holy days where the love of God and life everlasting is proclaimed. All of this we celebrated in the church with two family services, one dinner service, one contemplative service and a festive service on Easter morning.

As if all these services were not enough, we also have a lot to celebrate during the second part of spring:

On the 5th of May Danes will celebrate both The Liberation Day and The Great Prayer Day – the holiday where you eat 'hveder'. On the 14th of May Mothers are celebrated worldwide – Fathers are celebrated on the 18th of June. On the 18th of May Ascension Day is celebrated in Christian churches. On the 22nd of May I will learn what Victoria Day is all about, and on the 28th of May

spring ends its season full of celebrations with the celebration of Pentecost.

The list of holidays simply does not stop – and so time does not stop either. Spring is over before we know it. And June as well since we are celebrating both The Danish Constitution Day on the 5th of June and Sankt Hans (or Midsummer) on the 24th of June.

I still think it is a little weird that this is the last year we are to celebrate The Great Prayer Day since the Danish politicians decided to remove the holiday from 2024 and forward, but it sure is not because of lack of holidays throughout the spring — we still have plenty of festive days to gather around. Festive days that will make sure that spring is over before we know it — in a good way. And I am also sure that Danes will find other days to eat their 'hveder'. I guess you might be able to take away the holiday from a Dane, but Danes will always find ways to make 'hygge' with food. At least that is my experience.

I look forward to seeing you all throughout the rest of the spring and the beginning of the summer. Do not hesitate with making notes in the calendar about our upcoming events – the months will pass before you know it.

We will also have a cake for her in May so others can wish her well in her new ventures. I am sure we will continue to see Bodil's smiling face around the church in the future.

The new voice you hear when you call the office is our new church secretary, Penny Fraser. Penny has been working with Bodil over the last few months to ensure the transition was as painless as possible. So please welcome Penny to her new role as church secretary.

As of the writing of this report, we are preparing for events such as a Classical Guitar Concert by Mikkel Andersen from Denmark on April 19th, a visit from the Danish Ambassador, Hanne Eskjær on April 23rd, followed by a lunch for all the volunteers, and the Spring Work Party on April 29th.

The first Rummage Sale and Spring Tea since the Covid restrictions were removed, successfully took place in March. Thank you to all the volunteers who invested a lot of time to make these events successful. They would not have happened without your dedication and support.

The 88th AGM was held on Sunday, March 12th with a quorum of 44 members in attendance. A number of members were coming off the board and new ones elected to the board. 


