



# 100 years with a Danish church in Edmonton

Guests came all the way from Denmark. Among those were the newly appointed Bishop of Funen and the DSUK Churches Abroad, Mads Davidsen, the Dean of DSUK, Selma Ravn, and the president of DSUK, Anne Jensen.



It was a festive event, and a new altarpiece and organ were dedicated, something that was made possible due to the generous donation from the Granly Church. Bente and Manfred were present on behalf of Granly Church.

On the 16th of September the congregation had planned a Street Party. Music was played in and outside of the church, and people had a good opportunity to meet and mingle.

The church is located on a street with a lot of homeless people. They were invited as well and received free food and fun. It was a pleasure to see the church open to homeless during the celebration.

### Lucia

It is time to enroll if you want to participate in our annual Lucia Pop-Up Choir for children. No skills are required and there is no limit to the age. If you can participate in the practice and the performances, we would love to see you.

The children will have five rehearsals following Sunday services:

Besides practicing the traditional Lucia pageant, the children will also practice a 'nisse' play. Songs will be in both Danish and English (but you do not need to speak Danish).

Following the last rehearsal, the Lucia Choir will have their first performance for the seniors at Dania Home at 2-4pm.

#### 'Lucia Party' at the Danish Church

The children will perform their Lucia pageant and 'nisse' play on Saturday the 2<sup>nd</sup> of December at 7pm. From 6pm shops with Christmas crafts and homemade goodies will be open.



## 'Christmas by the Fireside' at the Scandinavian Community Center

On Friday the 8<sup>th</sup> of December at 6pm the Lucia Choir will perform their Lucia pageant and 'nisse' play as part of the 'Centers' Christmas celebration for children. Santa Claus will participate as well and it will be possible to buy Christmas sweets and drinks.
