From the Board

We have a lot of new initiatives underway but are starting to see the light at the end of the tunnel on some of them.

The Granly Legacy Scholarship Committee has awarded scholarships this year to a number of individuals in Burnaby schools. The criteria around these scholarships highlight Danish heritage and scholastic achievement.

In September we are doing a soft launch of our new website. What is a soft launch? Well, it is where people working on a new website decide that things are at a point where they should start showing it to a small group of people and get some feedback as to what works and what does not work. The goal is to have an actual launch of the new website in October. The Website Upgrade team has put in significant work in getting the site ready for launch. Thanks again for the dedication and work put in by these volunteers.

We are moving to a new accounting system because the current software is outdated and not supported anymore. We are taking this opportunity to restructure some of our accounts to better reflect the new initiatives we are undertaking. Thanks for the hard work of individuals working on this shift.

As mentioned in the Jul/Aug Newsletter, we are struggling with having volunteers take on the regular publication of the Kirkebladet. Thankfully, we have secured a Kirkebladet team that will help us bridge that gap for the next few years. The new team will be reaching out to members for information to fill the pages of Kirkebladets to come.

Our Cultural Family Coordinator, Camilla Ejsing, is now on board and working hard at getting activities underway for the younger generations such as Mini Confirmation and Yoga classes. You have probably seen some snippets of these activities in announcements on the Danish Lutheran Church of Vancouver Facebook page and Danes in Vancouver pages. Keep your eyes open for more programs as they are rolled out.

As always, a big thank you to our steadfast volunteers, who serve faithfully throughout the church and are too many to name here.

Enrollment for Confirmation 2024

Are you interested in being confirmed during the spring of 2024? Registration for classes has begun and we look forward to hearing from you. Confirmation is available for young teenagers throughout BC. Classes will be arranged depending on the participants and their circumstances. Classes can be virtual, physical, in-home, self-preparation, or a mix thereof.

In Denmark almost 70 % of the age group were confirmed in 2022 making it a widespread rite of passage between childhood and young adulthood. Also, confirmation confirms the promise given by God to each of us in our baptism. During the classes you will as a pupil get to discover your own spirituality by learning about Christianity and participating in rituals.

New Activity Baby/Toddler Group

As a new initiative the church wants to invite the youngest churchgoers and their parents (even parents to-be) to our new Baby/Toddler Group. As a start we will try to meet on the third Tuesday of each month starting from October 17th at 11am to 12noon.

The idea for this group is to make a cozy and save environment where new parents and parents tobe can come to meet and talk about – not only all the happy emotions and expectations one has welcoming a new baby into one's family – but also the fears and the hard work it is. For the babies and toddlers, we will roll out different motorized toys for them to play with. Also, if the participants wish for it, we can organize different activities like inviting a midwife or a musician.



New Activity Mini Confirmation

As a new initiative we want to invite children of all ages to classes of Mini Confirmation.

Mini Confirmation is a fun and creative activity for the children and their parents. You get to play and sing, be creative and connect with a Danish community. Each program of Mini Confirmation will consist of six biweekly classes and a program will be held in both the spring and the fall. The upcoming program will start on Thursday September 21st at 4pm to 5pm.

New Activity Youth Club

As a new initiative the Danish Church will try to establish a Youth Club. The Youth Club is an opportunity for teenagers to meet and participate in various activities together in and outside the church. You do not need to be confirmed to participate, but it is an ideal activity for those of you who want to stay connected with the church and a Danish community during and after your confirmation. The plan is for the club to meet on the 4th Thursday of each month.



Our first meeting of the club will be on September 28th at 5pm to 6pm. The activities we will do together will vary depending on the weather and what you wish for. For the first time we meet, we have planned on being outside the church where we will light a bonfire and make s'mores and 'snobroed'. Furthermore, we will introduce the young people to the Danish outdoor game 'kongespil'.

New Activity Yoga

As a new initiative the Danish Church will start offering classes of yoga. As a meditative form of exercise, yoga can help you grow both spiritually and physically. The church is happy that it can offer this to those of you who want to pursue this spiritual expression.



The Church will offer yoga on two levels for twelve consecutive Wednesdays during each fall and spring: Sitting yoga at 10am and Hatha yoga at 5pm. Each class will last an hour and you must bring your own mat for the Hatha yoga classes. We will start our classes on the 27th of September.
